

Logo formats

Vector logos and raster images are two different formats used in graphic design, each with its own characteristics, advantages, and disadvantages. All the below file types are accepted however vector is preferred whenever possible.

Vector

Vector graphics are created using mathematical equations to define shapes, lines, curves, and colors. Common vector formats are shown above.



Vector logos can be resized infinitely without loss of quality.

Vector files are often smaller than high-resolution raster images

Vector logos are ideal for branding because they can be used across various media and applications, ensuring consistency in visual identity.

Raster

Raster graphics are made up of pixels (small squares of color), which combine to create images. Common raster formats are shown below:



Increasing its size can result in pixelation (blocky appearance).

High-resolution raster images have larger file sizes. This is because they contain more pixels to represent detailed information.

To minimize pixelation and retain quality, it's often recommended to start with a high-resolution image and make careful adjustments, or to utilize vector graphics where appropriate, as vector images can be resized without loss of quality.

Colours

All artwork is printed in CMYK, please be aware different materials can show slight colour variation in the printing process, due to this we recommend that you provide the PMS code (pantone colour code) for each colour so this can be matched.



Fonts

When preparing files for print or digital distribution, it's essential to ensure that all text is properly handled to avoid any font-related issues. Here are the steps you can take to either embed fonts or convert them to outlines:



Converting Text to Outlines (Curves)

In Adobe Illustrator:

- Select the text you want to convert.
- Go to the menu and select Type → Create Outlines (or simply press Shift + Ctrl + O on Windows / Shift + Command + O on Mac).
- This converts the text into vector shapes, ensuring that it will look the same regardless of whether the font is installed on the system.



Providing Font Files

If you're unable to convert your text to outlines, you can include the font files when submitting your project.

Here's how you can do it:

- Locate the font file on your computer, which typically comes in formats such as .ttf (TrueType Font) or .otf (OpenType Font).
- Pack the font files along with your design files into a ZIP archive to ensure they are all submitted together.
- -By following these steps, you can avoid font issues and ensure that your designs appear exactly as intended.

What types of printing are available?

Gazebos can be printed using vinyl heat press or thermal dye-sublimation printing, Vinyl print is a good option for more basic artwork that require a fast turnaround however thermal dye-sublimation print is the better option and more cost effective in most cases.

What can be printed on a gazebo?

Gazebos can be printed with logos, text, photographs, or any other design, you can cover 100% of the area with dye sublimation printing.

Can I print on the inside of my gazebo?

Yes, you can print inside, outside or double sided on the gazebo walls, just simply select this when ordering.

What is the turnaround time?

Turnaround time for gazebo printing can vary depending on the service selected as shown below:-
Vinyl Print 5-7 business days

Thermal dye-sublimation printing 8-10 business day

Can I provide my own artwork?

Yes, you can provide your own artwork for printing on your gazebo, just download the template and if you have any questions or need any help we are just a call or email away.

What type of inks are used?

We use water-based, eco-friendly inks that are free from harmful chemicals.

This involves manually redrawing the logo to create a high-quality, scalable version, the cost for this professional tracing service is typically £17.99, inclusive of VAT, in most cases.

What format do I need to send my artwork in?

We require any logos and artwork in vector format, such as: Ai (Adobe Illustrator), EPS, SVG, or PDF (if vector graphic saved in pdf). Photographic images should be supplied in high resolution (300dpi) in JPG, TIFF, or PNG format. Please refer to our artwork guidelines for more information.
